Revised Recommendation to Award Bids

Dear Supervisor Goncalves:

Bids were received on December 7th, 2023 at 11 Main St, South Salem, NY 10590 for the Town of Lewisboro Oakridge Water District WTP Upgrades project.

A total of six (6) bids were received for the General Contract (1G), five (5) for the Electrical Contract (1E), and four (4) for the HVAC Contract (1H). The bid tabulations for each Contract are attached to this letter.

On December 11th, 2023, our office submitted a letter to the Town proposing the award of all three prime Contracts. Specifically, for Contract 1H, we recommended granting the contract to Sun-Dance Energy Contractors, Inc. at a cost of \$146,174.00. However, subsequent to this recommendation, the contractor formally withdrew their bid due to challenges in maintaining the bid price and meeting the MWBE utilization goals outlined in the Contract Documents, as required. Attached herewith is their formal bid withdrawal letter for your review.

The next lowest bidder in line is Mace Contracting Corp., offering a bid of \$195,000.00. Therefore, we offer the following revised recommendation.

We have reviewed the bids, have confirmed that the low bidders are responsive qualified bidders, and recommend award as follows:

- 1G, General Contract, to TAM Enterprises, Inc., \$2,882,933.00 for DWSRF 18893,
 \$296,230.00 for DWSRF 18592, and a contingency allowance of \$100,000.00, totaling
 \$3,279,163.00.
- 1E, Electrical Contract, to Acorn Electrical Contractors, \$120,000.00 for DWSRF 18893, \$30,000.00 for DWSRF 18592, and a contingency allowance of \$50,000.00, totaling \$200,000.00.
- 1H, HVAC Contract, to Mace Contracting Corp., \$130,000.00 for DWSRF 18893, \$55,000.00 for DWSRF 18592, and a contingency allowance of \$10,000.00, totaling \$195,000.00.

I am requesting that the Town Board waive the procurement policy and approve the purchase of the Automated External Defibrillators and outdoor cabinets from Advanced Emergency Devices as this vendor is the sole provider. Also, we are under a time constraint by the Governor's mandate to have the devices accessible for youth sports and day camps.

As a local company, the representative provides the below services at no additional cost and will notify the 911 system and have the cabinets and the codes added to the information for each address.

- On site Delivery and setup of all AEDs. All AEDs will be fully assembled at time of delivery.
- In- service training will be provided for the customer's staff on the operation and maintenance of the AED.
- Customer's staff will be aware of how to use and maintain the AED upon completion of in-service.
- Battery and Electrode expiration dates and corresponding AED serial numbers will be tracked by Advantage Emergency Devices. 60 days prior to the expiration date an email will be sent reminding the customer of the upcoming date and necessary replacements.







BOND RESOLUTION DATED FEBRUARY 13, 2024.

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF \$128,000 BONDS OF THE TOWN OF LEWISBORO, WESTCHESTER COUNTY, NEW YORK, TO PAY THE COST OF THE ACQUISITION OF A DUMP TRUCK, IN AND FOR SAID TOWN.

WHEREAS, all conditions precedent to the financing of the capital purpose hereinafter described, including compliance with the provisions of the State Environmental Quality Review Act to the extent required, have been performed; and

WHEREAS, it is now desired to authorize the financing of such capital purpose; NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT

RESOLVED, by the Town Board of the Town of Lewisboro, Westchester County, New York (the "Town"), as follows:

Section 1. For the purpose of paying the cost of the acquisition of a dump truck, in and for the Town, including incidental expenses in connection therewith, a specific object or purpose, there are hereby authorized to be issued up to \$128,000 bonds of said Town pursuant to the provisions of the Local Finance Law.

Section 2. It is hereby determined that the estimated maximum cost of the aforesaid specific object or purpose is \$128,000, and the plan for the financing thereof shall be by the issuance of the \$128,000 bonds authorized to be issued pursuant to this bond resolution.

Section 3. It is hereby further determined that the period of probable usefulness of the aforesaid specific object or purpose is fifteen years pursuant to subdivision twenty-eight of paragraph a of Section 11.00 of the Local Finance Law, as said object or purpose shall cost \$30,000 or more. It is hereby further determined that the maximum maturity of the bonds authorized will exceed five years.

Section 4. Subject to the provisions of the Local Finance Law, the power to authorize the issuance of and to sell bond anticipation notes in anticipation of the issuance and sale of the bonds herein authorized, including renewals of such notes, is hereby delegated to the Supervisor,

the chief fiscal officer. Such notes shall be of such terms, form and contents, and shall be sold in such manner, as may be prescribed by said Supervisor, consistent with the provisions of the Local Finance Law.

Section 5. The faith and credit of said Town are hereby irrevocably pledged to the payment of the principal of and interest on such obligations as the same respectively become due and payable. An annual appropriation shall be made in each year sufficient to pay the principal of and interest on such obligations becoming due and payable in such year. To the extent such appropriation is not made from other sources, there shall annually be levied on all the taxable real property of said Town a tax sufficient to pay the principal of and interest on such obligations as the same become due and payable.

Section 6. Such bonds shall be in fully registered form and shall be signed in the name of the Town by the manual or facsimile signature of the Supervisor and a facsimile of its corporate seal shall be imprinted or impressed thereon and may be attested by the manual or facsimile signature of the Town Clerk.

Section 7. The powers and duties of advertising such bonds for sale, conducting the sale and awarding the bonds, are hereby delegated to the Supervisor, who shall advertise such bonds for sale, conduct the sale, and award the bonds in such manner as the Supervisor shall deem best for the interests of the Town; provided, however, that in the exercise of these delegated powers, the Supervisor shall comply fully with the provisions of the Local Finance Law and any order or rule of the State Comptroller applicable to the sale of municipal bonds. The receipt of the Supervisor shall be a full acquittance to the purchaser of such bonds, who shall not be obliged to see to the application of the purchase money.

Section 8. All other matters, except as provided herein relating to such bonds, including determining whether to issue such bonds having substantially level or declining annual debt service and all matters related thereto, prescribing whether manual or facsimile signatures shall appear on said bonds, prescribing the method for the recording of ownership of said bonds, appointing the fiscal

agent or agents for said bonds, providing for the printing and delivery of said bonds (and if said bonds are to be executed in the name of the Town by the facsimile signature of its Supervisor, providing for the manual countersignature of a fiscal agent or of a designated official of the Town), the date, denominations, maturities and interest payment dates, place or places of payment, and also including the consolidation with other issues, shall be determined by the Supervisor. It is hereby determined that it is to the financial advantage of the Town not to impose and collect from registered owners of such bonds any charges for mailing, shipping and insuring bonds transferred or exchanged by the fiscal agent, and, accordingly, pursuant to paragraph c of Section 70.00 of the Local Finance Law, no such charges shall be so collected by the fiscal agent. Such bonds shall contain substantially the recital of validity clause provided for in Section 52.00 of the Local Finance Law and shall otherwise be in such form and contain such recitals in addition to those required by Section 52.00 of the Local Finance Law, as the Supervisor shall determine.

Section 9. This resolution shall constitute a statement of official intent for purposes of Treasury Regulations Section 1.150 - 2. Other than as specified in this resolution, no monies are, or are reasonably expected to be, reserved, allocated on a long-term basis, or otherwise set aside with respect to the permanent funding of the object or purpose described herein.

Section 10. The validity of such bonds and bond anticipation notes may be contested only if:

- (1) Such obligations are authorized for an object or purpose for which said Town is not authorized to expend money, or
- (2) The provisions of law which should be complied with at the date of publication of this resolution are not substantially complied with,

and an action, suit or proceeding contesting such validity is commenced within twenty days after the date of such publication, or

(3) Such obligations are authorized in violation of the provisions of the Constitution.
