EXECUTIVE SESSION – Lease/Purchase/Sale of Real Property

PARKING – Drawing for Spring Street Parking Lot Permits

A drawing was held to award parking permits for the Spring Street parking lot. 20 applications were drawn from a box and those applicants will be given a parking permit valid for one year. Because the Presbyterian Church has not finalized its agreement to provide parking spaces for commuters who did not get a Spring Street lot permit, the Town has agreed to postpone implementation of the permit requirements.
