Ms. McGinn called the meeting to order at 7:30 p.m.

I. MINUTES

Review and adoption of the Minutes of the Comprehensive Plan Steering Committee meeting held on October 26, 2021.

Review and adoption of the Minutes of the Comprehensive Plan Steering Committee meeting held on November 9, 2021.

Review and adoption of the Minutes of the Comprehensive Plan Steering Committee meeting held on November 23, 2021.

Review and adoption of the Minutes of the Comprehensive Plan Steering Committee meeting held on November 30, 2021.

Ms. McGinn made a motion to accept the minutes as presented; seconded by Ms. Indelicato. In favor: Charlene Indelicato, Larry Mango, Katie McGinn and John Wolff. Absent: Mark Robbins.

II. GUEST SPEAKER

Norma Drummond, Commissioner of the Westchester County Department of Planning, discussed the first data release of the 2020 Census; this data is for political redistricting purposes and focuses on the over 18 population. She noted that a lot more data such as detailed age/ethnicity/housing data will be coming out next year.

Ms. Drummond stated Westchester County's population broke a million people and is 1,004,457. She noted that American Community (65-question/monthly) survey data is taken from about 300,000 households and the (9-question/decennial) Census provides our county with better data.

Some other 2020 Census highlights include:

- US population is 331,449.281 (up 7.4%);
- US housing units is 140,498,736 (up 6.7%);
- New York is the fourth most populous state in the US;
- Westchester County is the 48th largest county in the US;
- Lewisboro had the 10th best response rate in the county;
- almost 80% of Lewisboro's population self-responded to the census; and
- Lewisboro had a 1.2% decrease in population (146 fewer people in 2020 than 2010 Census).

III. RFP

Ms. McGinn noted that responses to the RFP are coming in and the Committee will be conducting initial interviews and then making its recommendations to the Town Board. She noted that this is Phase 1, an introductory phase geared toward hiring a consulting firm which will be followed by Phase 2, the Community engagement phase.


