#### Acceptance of the January Meeting Minutes

#### Food Scrap Recycling

- 1. Food Scrap Recycling Update Jessica Gallagher, Sarah Coccaro
  - a. Janet Harckham will be proposing to have the scrap food recycling location be at the Elementary School that is currently being used as an auxiliary town office building.
  - b. RFP for haulers may need to be re-issued, the RFP has been sent to the Town Board for review. If needed, bids would be due by April 1st, 2022.
  - c. Locations to sell kits at local farmer markets: Gossets Farmer Market, John Jay Homestead, and others.

  - a. Sarah requested topics from the group for social media posts.
  - b. Upcoming posts and topics NY ban on polystyrene,
  - c. Dan Welsh will add Sarah Coccaro as an admin for the Lewisboro Sustainability Facebook account.
  - d. Proposed to develop a "green" town newsletter option that would subscribe people to a subset of town committees. Coordination with other committees and the town will be needed to complete.

#### Events

- 1. Earth Day Event Chris Coccaro
  - a. Current plan is a kick off event for the Food Scrap Recycling Program
  - b. Potential Back-up programs
    - i. Guided nature walks
    - ii. Roadway / litter clean up
    - iii. EV demonstration day
    - iv. Electric Lawn Equipment Rebates
- 2. Community Solar Campaign Dan Welsh
  - a. Coordination with Sustainable Westchester has been completed, kick-off date is pending.
- 3. Landscaping Rebate Program Robert Fischman
  - a. Current plan is to kick off the program in the spring.
  - b. Final vendor list will be set by February 19th.

#### Town of Lewisboro Coordination

- 1. Letter Recommending Adoption of Stretch Code Robert Fischman
  - a. Town Board will propose adoption of the stretch code will be moved to March 14th
  - Town would need to enact the stretch code by June 2022 to qualify for Clean Energy Communities Credit.
- 2. EV Charging Proposal Dan Welsh & Robert Fischman
  - a. NYSDEC application was not accepted.

- b. Blink has provided two proposals for EV chargers
  - i. Town-owned equipment: ~\$100,000
  - ii. Blink-owned equipment, owned for 9-years where Blink would set the charging rates.

#### Climate Smart Community and Clean Energy Community

- 1. Climate Smart Community Accreditation Status Dan Welsh and Tom Kelly
  - a. The committee has reviewed the action items that are needed to achieve bronze level status and will develop a plan to achieve them.
  - b. Greenhouse Gas Inventory Dan Welsh
    - i. Dan and Tom will develop an RFP for GHG inventory and benchmarking.
- 2. Clean Energy Community High Impact Action Items Robert Fischman
  - a. Building code inspector training Coordinating a training program that qualifies for PDH credits and clean energy community credit.
  - b. Committee will run a community solar and clean heating campaigns for these action items. The Clean Heat Campaign will need 5 homes to make energy improvements where 3 of them include heat pumps.
- 3. Community Energy Coach Program Robert Fischman
  - a. This could be moved to a campaign or funded under a grant.

#### Funding and Grants

- 1. Grant funding and status Tom Kelly
  - a. NYSERDA will be receiving funding from the RGGI funds to support heat pump programs.
    Timing for these rebates is currently unknown.
