Food Scrap Recycling

- 1. Food Scrap Recycling Update Jessica Gallagher & Sarah Coccaro:
 - a. Bob Fischman regarding County / Erika Pierce organized a tour of the Material Reclamation site at Valhalla.
 - b. Material from Hunts Pt Market. Mt Vernon group picks up and brings; city adds "browns". 8 or so bays, each maybe 5 yards. 1 person with FL Loader. Checks chemistry/bio, moves through. Screener for final soil. 2 legislative aides discussed creation of a facility in NWC. Self run or contract out. Contemplated how to organize, perhaps SW in the middle, perhaps the site at Hilltop H. Ryan in Erika's office is reaching out to Peter Kuniholm in Bedford to discuss.
 - c. Consider expansion: next budget year? For Vista? DEC grant (min 100k but 50% match)
- 2. NYSDEC Food Scrap Recycling Grant Robert Fischman
 - a. DEC grant 100k 2mm, but next year it will be too late.
