Following a discussion, the committee agreed upon the following Mission, Vision and Goals:

LHC Mission Statement:

The mission of the Lewisboro Housing Committee (LHC) is to assist Town officials and residents in sourcing quality affordable housing in Lewisboro for individuals and families seeking to live here. We seek a balance of housing opportunities, including for those with low and moderate income and regardless of race, color, national origin, age, ability, religion or sex, including pregnancy, sexual orientation and gender identity.

Vision – An examination of what Lewisboro should be 5, 10 or 20 years from now...

LHC Vision:

A town with a diverse range of housing opportunities, sensitive to its environmental impact and meeting the needs of our community today and tomorrow.

Goals:

Housing available in all six hamlets within Lewisboro that is mixed use, flexible, as well as aesthetically and environmentally appropriate for our semi-rural area. While meeting the various communities' housing needs, we must be mindful of allowances for open space, ADA compliance and housing for senior citizens by increasing the variety and availability of housing for diverse populations.
