Some Highlights

- In August 2020 NYS Dept of Health lowered the PFAS levels to 10 ppt from 70 ppt. More information can be found here:

- In May of 2021 PFAS-mitigation design and construction plans were submitted to the Westchester County Department of Health. The process of securing DOH approval was iterative and time consuming.
 - Design included additional upgrades including DOH required not related to PFAS
- The Westchester County Department of Health approved Delaware Engineering's plans and specifications for our upgraded water plant on August 8, 2023
- In a critical parallel effort, the town applied for a federal EPA grant in April 2021 and a New York State Environmental Facilities Corporation Water Infrastructure Improvement Act grant in November of 2021



Some Highlights

- Our project was awarded both an EPA and an EFC grant in April of 2022 in the amounts of \$1.8 and \$1.16 million dollars respectively. Total=\$2.96M
- We received approval [August 2023] from both the EPA and the EFC to start the bid process.
- The Town Board authorized going to bid for the plant upgrade project at the September 18, 2023, town board meeting.
- Bids were received on December 7, 2023 and a recommendation to award by Delaware Engineering followed
- Town Board will need to award contracts
- Expectation is that we will start construction in May 2024
- Estimated completion May 2025



Some Highlights

Note: Until the project is completed, DOH will continue to require that each well be tested for PFAS on a quarterly basis. Anytime a single well tests for levels above the 10 ppt, DOH requires that a notice be posted. The notice itself goes through an approval process with County DOH. Please expect to see these notices every quarter. The water leaving the plant continues to test below 10 ppt.



Project Funding

- Public Hearing August 9th 2021: Oakridge Water District PFAS Treatment Project
- We held off on the actual borrowing resolution until we were assured that by passing this resolution it would not impact the federal grant we were applying for.
 - It was determined that the borrowing resolution would not impact the federal grant
 - The bond resolution is required as part of the WIIA application
 - To meet the WIIA application schedule, bond resolution was placed on the Oct. 12, 2021 Town Board agenda
 - We applied for NYS EFC WIIA grant prior to its deadline of Nov. 22, 2021
- From Town Board meeting on Oct. 12, 2021
 - Two Items on the agenda
 - Public Interest Order (...declares that it is in the public's interest to proceed with the upgrade project).
 - Resolution Authorizing the Issuance of Bonds
