The Lewisboro Town Park Playground Improvement Corp. (LPP) is pleased to present a check for \$12,000 to the Town of Lewisboro, NY. These funds were donated by Lewisboro community members, local businesses, and committee members of LPP. This is the third check presented to the town and is intended for the Lewisboro Town Park Playground.

In collaboration with Nicole Caviola, Recreation Supervisor, and The Lewisboro Parks and Recreation Department we are gifting these funds to cover freight and the purchase of two new pieces of equipment: the Log Crawl Tunnel and the Communication Board. The tunnel will replace the T-Rex rider who unfortunately did not stand the test of time. The pictures and symbols on the Communication Board will offer another way for non-verbal, speech-challenged, and early learning individuals to communicate at the playground.

At this time, the Lewisboro Recreation Department will be responsible for the unloading, transportation, re-spreading of sand area, and installation of both Log Crawl Tunnel and Communication Board for the lowest of three quotes of \$5,400 from Pat Corsetti, Inc. The Lewisboro Town Park Playground Project is committed to reimburse these installation costs of \$5,400 come Fall of 2024.
