A PROGRAM OF SUSTAINABLE WESTCHESTER

Westchester Power is a community bulk-purchasing program for **electricity supply**.

Also known as a Community Choice Aggregation (CCA).

History in a nutshell

Westchester Power program started in April 2016 with 20 municipalities. Now there are 24.

NYSEG towns: Bedford, Lewisboro, North Salem, Pound Ridge & Somers.

Current contract runs until April 30, 2019.

New contract will start on May 1, 2019.



Recap: Two supply options to choose from.



Recap: Low-cost fixed rates.

- Energy suppliers had to bring us rates that are **lower than the average NYSEG rate over the previous 12 months** for both the basic supply and the green supply.

Recap: What changes and what remains the same for residents and small businesses?

Your electricity supplier changes. You have a fixed rate and a renewable energy option.

Delivery and billing stay the same. NYSEG is still responsible for delivering your power and you are still billed by NYSEG on one bill.

Residents enrolled	Rolling basis starting May 1, 2019
