The Highway Department

- Maintains all Town of Lewisboro owned roads.
- Trims trees and removes brush within Town right-of-way.
- Does drainage work.
- Removes dead trees within Town right-of-way.
- Plows & sands Town owned roads.
- Mows, sweeps and cleans Town roadsides.
- Cleans and replaces catch basins.
- Replacement and maintenance of all road signs.
- Issues driveway permits and subsequent approvals of completed driveways according to Town specifications.
- Issues original common driveway permits and subsequent approvals after construction has met Town specifications.

The Town of Lewisboro consists of ninety-six miles of roads, eleven of which are dirt roads. The Highway Department's budget is approximately two million dollars per year.
